1. Customer-Generator (C-G) Information

5. Net Surplus Generation (Mark one)

C-G may choose to receive compensation for Net Surplus Generation (i.e., excess generation exported to the City electric grid) by marking "Yes" below and by providing a completed IRS W-9 form. If C-G prefers to retain all renewable attributes for all excess generation, mark "No" below, in which case the IRS W-9 form is not required. If no selection is made, C-G will not be enrolled in the Net Surplus Program. C-G may change this election by providing written notice, effective on a prospective basis.

Yes: C-G elects to participate in the Net Surplus Program to receive compensation for all excess generation (completed IRS W-9 required).
 No: C-G elects to not participate in the Net Surplus Program, retaining all renewable attributes of all C-G generation, and no IRS W-9 form is required.

1 _____	¹ Starting with the first month of interconnection of the Equipment, C-G is subject to: a service fee of \$7/month, applicable non-bypassable charge, and all other Electric services charges otherwise applicable to the C-G's assigned rate class. Fees and rates may be periodically updated by the City.
2 _____	² Interconnecting Equipment to the City's electric grid does not guarantee (a.k.a., "lock in") electric rates or electric rate structure(s) for electric services provided by the City. C-G is responsible to pay all charges applicable at the time of monthly billing, which may be based on rates and rate structures that differ from those applicable at the time the Equipment is interconnected to the City's electric grid. This may include new or modified non-volumetric charges (\$/month), demand-based charges (\$/kW), time-of-use rate structures, tiered rate structures, or other rate structures.
3 _____	³ All billing is conducted and finalized on a monthly basis, except when correcting for billing errors.
4 _____	⁴ C-G shall be billed for all electricity the City delivers to the premises under applicable retail electric rate structures and rates. The City shall compensate the C-G for all electricity received from the premises at the Net Surplus Compensation Rate (bill credit) if the C-G is enrolled in the Net Surplus Program. Electricity that is produced by the C-G and consumed on site measured on an instantaneous basis shall not be charged the applicable "Energy Rate."
5 _____	⁵ C-G understands that the City has written materials on its website (www.CityOfShastaLake.org/Solar) and City staff are available to assist C-G in understanding the interconnection process and program details (COSLSolar@CityOfShastaLake.Org ; 530-275-7400).
6 _____	⁶ City shall issue a Form 1099 to the C-G and IRS for any credits issued to C-G under the Program.

By signing this form, the Customer-Generator (C-G) acknowledges understanding and agreement with each of the following as terms to their interconnection to the City of Shasta Lake electric grid:

1. All information provided in this Form A is true, accurate, and complete.
2. All C-Gs must at all times operate equipment that is interconnected to the City's electric grid in a safe and responsible manner and comply with all applicable rules, laws, regulations, and any other applicable requirement, including but not limited to the City of Shasta Lake Customer-Generator Interconnection Policy and the City of Shasta Lake Net Energy Metering Tariff. The City has the right to lock-off or disconnect the C-G's equipment if, under the City's sole determination, the equipment is not installed or is not operated within these requirements or is causing power quality issues on the electric grid.
3. A compliant electric revenue meter is required for all distributed generation equipment interconnecting to the City's electric infrastructure. The meter is capable of measuring the C-G's kWh consumption from the City's electric grid, and in the event the energy generated by the equipment exceeds the energy consumed, the meter will also measure the kWh that the City receives back to the electric grid from the C-G's equipment. All energy (kWh) delivered and received after the C-G serves its own instantaneous load with its equipment shall be measured by the multi-register meter. The C-G will receive a credit, at the surplus energy compensation rate, for energy the City receives, if enrolled in the Net Surplus Program; and C-G will be billed consumption charges for the energy delivered by the City, based on the rate and rate structure applicable at that time on a monthly basis.
4. The City shall furnish a compliant electric meter at the C-G's sole expense. The City shall maintain ownership of the meter and shall be responsible for its maintenance.
5. The C-G desires to interconnect equipment to the City's electric grid and requests the NEM A-2 program design and billing procedures described herein.
