As spring winds down and summer approaches, now is a great time to begin clearing dead grass and removing any debris that may pose a fire hazard around your home. We are happy to reach out to the property owner with a friendly reminder.

Several exciting City projects are either wrapping up or launching this month. The long-anticipated "Drop-In Skate ~ Shasta Lake" Skatepark is ready for its grand opening, with a ribbon-cutting ceremony scheduled for Saturday, June 14th at 10:00 AM. The City Council allocated \$1.5 million to bring this incredible asset to our community, and the event promises fun for all ages.

Another long-awaited improvement is the lighting upgrade project at Margaret Polf Park. This project, years in the making, will enhance safety and visibility at the park with new lighting and related improvements.

Now let's talk summer! With school out, many families are diving into summer activities. I remember how challenging it could be to juggle childcare during the summer months. Luckily, local options are available: Gateway Unified School District will host a summer school camp beginning June 6th, followed by Camp Shasta Lake, hosted by Redding Recreation. CHECK FOR WATER LEAKS - SAVE WATER AND MONEY!

Water leaks are more common than you might think, and can quietly waste thousands of gallons of water and lead to high utility bills.

The City of Shasta Lake encourages all customers to regularly check for leaks inside and outside the home. Start by inspecting faucets, toilets, irrigation systems, and your water meter. A toilet that runs continuously or a dripping outdoor spigot can add up quickly. If your water bill seems unusually high, it's worth investigating.

Early leak detection can prevent property damage and costly repairs. If you suspect a leak and need assistance locating it, contact a licensed plumber or our Utility Department at (530) 275-7400.
