The following rates and compensation are fixed and established as the rates to be charged and collected by the city's wastewater department:

\* Single Family Equivalency Connection (SFEC) Charge

**Footnote(s):**

1. Residential accounts include single-family residences, mobile homes, multi-family, and accessory dwelling units (ADUs).
2. One SFEC equals one hundred seventy (170) gallons (per day (five thousand one hundred sixty-eight (5,168) gallons per month) of wastewater flow, which is the estimated flow from a typical single-family household.
3. Non-residential SFECs based on an average monthly water consumption for January, February and March, with a minimum charge of one SFEC.
4. Industrial accounts have the choice to: (1) To be billed based on the average monthly water consumption for January, February and March, with a minimum charge of one SFEC; or (2) install a flowmeter in the lateral and pay for one hundred (100) percent of the wastewater discharged with a minimum charge of one SFEC.
